

# Milford Community School Use Program

## Biddy Basketball

The Biddy Basketball League is an in-town basketball program open to all boys and girls regardless of ability or experience. This is a 10 game season for grades 3-8 and a 5 week season for grade 2. There will be one scheduled practice a week for grades 3-8. All games are played on Saturdays at varying times each week. A full game and practice schedule will be provided at the beginning of the season.

**Grades 3-8** - Dec. 7, 2019 to Feb.15, 2020 - **Grade 2** - Jan. 4, 2020 to Feb. 1, 2020

\*no games will be played on December 28th

**Grade 2** - Instructional only - develop fundamental skills

**Grade 3/4** - Competitive with modifications - introduce the game of basketball to developing players

**Grade 5/6** - Competitive - full competitive play following the Biddy Basketball rules

**Grade 7/8** - Competitive - full competitive play following the Biddy Basketball rules. Fouls will be called and can result in disqualifications

**Milford Resident Fee:** \$85 per child      **Non-Resident Fee:** \$95 per child

**Deadline to Register: Friday, November 1, 2019 @ 12:00 PM**

After November 1st we will begin placing players on a **wait list**. There is no guarantee that wait listed players will be placed on a team. To secure your spot on the wait list, you must submit a paper registration form along with payment made by check, money order or exact cash to the Milford Community Program office. Online registration will not be available at this time.

Once registered there will be no refunds unless we are not able to place your child. Additionally, we are not able to honor requests to move players to another team or place players together on a team. Exceptions will be made for siblings playing in the same division.
